Declare an emergency due to Johns Loop Road becoming impassable and a public safety risk after washing out on Friday, June 3rd during a heavy rain, and authorize procurement of an immediate repair by Public Works Director Bobby Groves, Magistrate Marty Chandler and County Judge Executive Jim Henderson. Judge Henderson reported to the court that the Administrative Code is being revised and he is working with Finance Officer Nicole Law, who is most responsible for payroll, and the constitutional officers to work toward uniform policies to streamline the payroll process. The revised document will reflect effects of a new federal labor law regarding overtime for exempt salaried employees. Judge Henderson hopes to have changes in effect by the first payroll in July as the new fiscal year 2016-2017 begins. The Administrative Code's last revision was in 2008 and is amended by ordinance which requires two readings. Court members were asked to review the current Administrative Code and suggest any areas they see in need of revision. Consensus of the court was that since the county has increased its appropriation to the park by \$35,000, a separate appropriation for fireworks would not be made this year as has been done in the past few years. County Attorney Sam Phillips reminded folks to pay delinquent property taxes before the early August tax sale. Emergency Management Director Bob Palmer reported that the process has begun for the required update of the Five-year Hazard Mitigation Plan. Public Works Director Bobby Groves reported that trees have been cut and water line moved on Carl Gore Road in preparation for culvert replacement.
